# Qing Palace offers sumptuous Chinese New Year cuisine

The Happiness set menu, priced at RM668++ per table of 10 persons also comprises dishes like the salmon yee sang, steamed *patin* fish Hong Kong style and others.

The Longevity set menu is priced at RM788++ per table of 10 persons. Guests can sample dishes like steamed garoupa fish Hong Kong style, braised dried seafood with black mushroom and the famous crispy pan-fried *nian gao*.

Palace's special abalone yee sang, camphor and tea smoked duck, steamed codfish Hong Kong style, sautéed prawn with broccoli, gut-

mus rice in lotus leaf, and soy pan-fried *siang gao* and others.

In addition, a Chinese New Year must-do is having family and friends tossing the yee sang, which is believed to bring good luck and prosperity.

The chef has prepared a line-up of two types of yee sang for guests to *lo hei* (tossing) for prosperity and wealth for the New Year.

From 2M40++ guests will be able to sample the salmon yee sang.

For RM590++ onwards, guests will also be able to try out the exquisite abalone yee sang. To accompany its meals, it has an extensive list of Chinese teas, among its beverages.

The reunion and Chinese New Year set menus and yee sang promotion at Qing Palace Chinese Restaurant will be available only from the Feb 1 to 24. All dishes are pork free and alcohol free.

The all-day dining Glensagles Terrace Restaurant will also be offering Lunar New Year specialties perfectly suitable for family reunions and gatherings.
